Born, Hans Dr. is a Fellow at DCAF and is DCAF coordinator of the working groups on “parliamentary accountability of the security sector” as well as “legal aspects of security sector governance”. He holds a BA in History from the University of Wales and an MA in War Studies from Kings College, University of London. He has been an analyst at the U.S. Library of Congress and a Research Fellow at the Royal Institute of International Affairs.
