Guidelines for Contributors

Although many articles are commissioned, unsolicited articles are welcomed. Authors may expect to hear a decision within two months of acknowledgement. *International Issues & Slovak Foreign Policy* is a refereed journal.

Articles should be original and deliver the data that are accurate, meaningful and timely. It should not be under consideration elsewhere. The text should be submitted to editors in the simple Word document format with an abstract summarizing the main points. The length of contributions should not exceed 6,000 words. Quotation should be clearly gathered in a manageable proportion as footnotes. Footnotes should be presented as follows:
