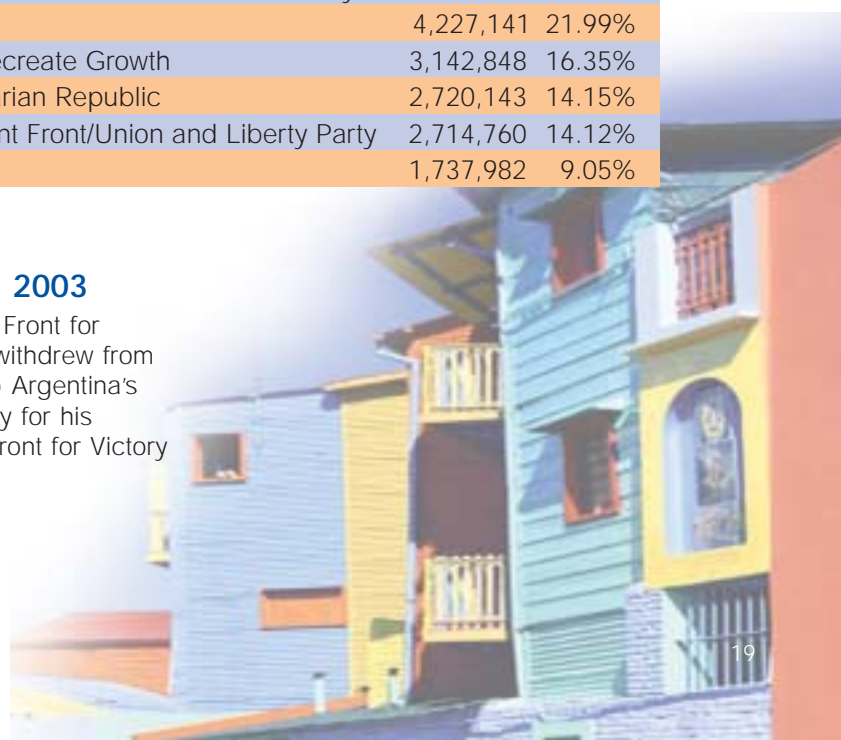

Presidential (Second Round) ■ May 18, 2003

Presidential candidate Carlos Saul Menem of the Front for Loyalty Alliance/Union of the Democratic Center withdrew from the second round presidential race. According to Argentina's electoral law, Menem's withdrawal cleared the way for his second round opponent, Nestor Kirchner of the Front for Victory Alliance party, to be named president by default.
