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Michael P. Mortara, who received a Bachelor of Science in Foreign Service in 1971 from Georgetown University's Edmund A. Walsh School of Foreign Service and an MBA in 1974 from the University of Chicago, was a founding patron of the *Journal* and of Georgetown's Wall Street Alliance. Through the Michael and Virginia Mortara Foundation, Mr. Mortara bolstered several University schools and programs, especially the School of Foreign Service with the establishment of the Michael and Virginia Mortara Chair for a Distinguished Professor in the Practice of Diplomacy. Mr. Mortara likewise distinguished himself professionally. He was instrumental in the development of mortgage-backed securities and held prominent and influential positions with the Wall Street firms of Salomon Brothers and Goldman Sachs and its affiliate, GS Ventures, for which he served as Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer.
